Technical Program

- Audio indexing (audio, speech, music)
- Audio content extraction
- Multi-modal and cross-modal indexing

Multimedia Information Retrieval

- Multimedia retrieval (image, audio, video, ...)
- Matching and similarity search
- Content-based search
- Multimedia data mining
- Multimedia recommendation
- Large scale multimedia database management

Multimedia Browsing and Presentation

- Summarisation, browsing and organization of multimedia content
- Personalization and content adaptation
- User interaction and relevance feedback
- Multimedia interfaces, presentation and visualization tools

All accepted and registered papers will be published in the workshop proceedings which will be indexed and distributed by the IEEEExplore.

Selected papers will appear, after extension and peer-review, in a special issue of Multimedia Tools and Applications.

Paper submission

Prospective authors are invited to submit full papers of not more than six (6) pages including results, figures and references. Papers will be accepted only by electronic submission through the EasyChair site. Style files (Latex and Word) will be provided for the convenience of the authors.
